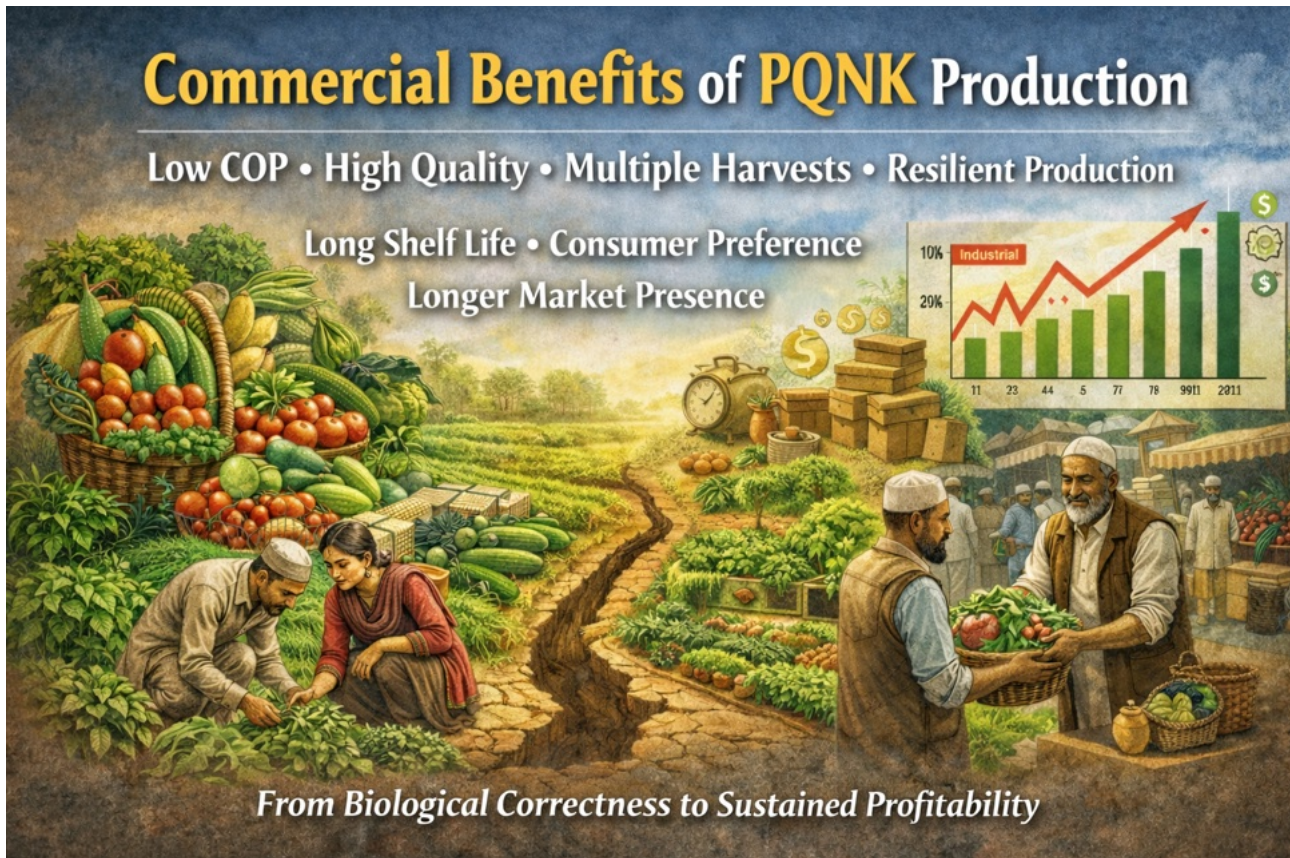


Commercial Advantages of PQNK Production
